Used by more than 520 million Chinese consumers, Alipay provides a safe, swift and easy-to-use way for merchants and individuals to do business with each other. Signing up to Alipay in Cambridge is straight-forward by following these 4 steps:

Step 1: Request a Merchant Registration Form

Cambridge China Centre will provide the Merchant Registration Form.

The completed form and supporting documents are to be returned to enquiry@cambridgechinacentre.org



Step 2: Sign the Contract

Once receiving the Merchant Registration Form, Cambridge China Centre will provide the contract to sign up with Yuan Capital (the FCA regulated acquirer of Alipay). Completed contracts are be returned to enquiry@cambridgechinacentre.org

Service Type	Fees
QR Code Board	No installation fee. No rental fee.
Alipay Terminal	No installation fee. £10 monthly rental fee per terminal. *If merchants choose the 3 month trial contract, £100 deposit per terminal applies within the trial period.
PoS Integration	No installation fee. £10 monthly maintenance fee for each login account

Transaction fees:

- 1.2 % for the supermarket merchants.
- 1.6 % for the hospitality merchants.
- 1.8 % for other merchants.
